Footnotes

SIBERIAN PARADOX tried to contest the pace early but could not keep up, took back and was kept outside horses, raced five wide and advanced to the stretch, responded when straightened and drove clear late. SHAKE'EM UP dueled on the pace three wide to the turn, responded to take a short lead to mid stretch, dug in when challenged by the winner and stayed on gamely before giving way late. ITALIAN WINE was outrun early, saved ground on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and was finishing willingly. LAVA LIL vied for the lead from between rivals to the turn, responded and remained a factor to mid stretch then tired in the final furlong. FUNKY HABIT was caught up in the speed duel from the rail to the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. TRUCE IN PECOS contested the pace four wide for a half then gave out.
