CAN I CALL YOU DAD broke cleanly and tracked the pace from the inside to the half, moved off the rail and advanced three wide on the second turn, forged to the front in the upper stretch and edged clear then held off WOODFORD PRINCESS in the final stages. WOODFORD PRINCESS trailed to the second turn, offered a bold rally from the inside to the furlong pole, shifted out and continued to close. NATIVE HEARTBEAT was permitted to settle early from the inside, moved well off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back over to be two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. ROYAL TERESA set all of the pace uncontested from the rail to the quarter pole, met the winner's bid into the stretch, battled briefly then gave out. CARTE MADERA prompted the pace two wide for six furlongs and slackened. GONETHEDOCTOR raced unhurried early, tried to rally while three wide on the second turn but came up empty. LITIGATOR stalked the pace three wide early but could not go on into the second turn and faded.
