Footnotes

TABARCIA settled early from the inside and well off the pace, advanced gradually on the backstretch and second turn two wide, responded in mid stretch with a late surge and got up in the final stride. PALE GOLD stalked the pace from the rail, shifted out to offer her bid into the stretch two wide, led nearing the furlong pole then just failed to hold. KEEP THE RING settled from the rail early, remained inside on the second turn to rally into the stretch but lost much of her punch. NIKKI NIKKI DOO was unhurried early from the outside, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but came lacked the needed response. PRIZED BUY lagged to the stretch then finished in a mild rally. TWO ELEVEN lacked early speed, offered a mild bid into the stretch then flattened out. HOMEMADE VIDEO set the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave out. KARIZMA prompted the pace from the outside, stopped into the second turn and was eased late but walked off.
