Hal's Pal was forwardly placed from the outside without need of urging, advanced gradually three wide to the stretch, got to terms with General Royal in midstretch and pulled clear late. General Royal set all of the pace under good rating, responded in the drive but could not contain the winner late. Wild Wonder stalked the pace from the rail, was sent after General Royal into the second turn, but lacked the needed response, angled off the rail late but still did not respond. Mister Fire Eyes, never far back, went three wide on the second turn, loomed a bold factor at the head of the lane but flattened out in the final eighth. Profound Secret failed to reach serious contention. March Of Kings flash speed but faded steadily and returned bleeding for both nostrils.
