### Footnotes

JETINTO HOUSTON had good speed, dueled to the turn, put away OFF TO THE OPERA and edged clear to the stretch then widened in handy fashion. CHRISTMAS TIME was outsprinted but stalked the leaders to the turn, came two then three wide to the stretch, could not threaten the winner but caught PHEIFFER for the place. PHEIFFER was outrun early but pulled three wide to prompt the pace on the turn then faded in the final furlong. GONOTORULE was crowded between OFF TO THE OPERA and NORMANDY PRINCESS at the start, settled to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but lacked a late response. OFF TO THE OPERA came out slightly at the start, dueled for the lead to mid turn but gave way through the drive. NORMANDY PRINCESS had no speed and saved ground without being a factor.
