Footnotes

Anne O ' Keefe was permitted to settle early, set out after the leaders on the turn from the inside, angled out then dug in once straightened for the drive and rallied smartly two win going away. Truly A Deb pressed the pace two wide, forged to the front a furlong out but could not hold the winner. Pearls N Lace stalked the leaders from the inside but failed to respond. Llanelli was well placed just outside the leaders but didn't rally. Living Dreams raced wide throughout and came up empty. Prize Strudel had no early speed while racing well off the rail, remained five wide to the stretch then closed a bit of ground. Bud's Golden Girl rushed up after a slow start from the rail but had nothing left for the drive. Little Snooter turned in a dull effort from the outside.
