**Footnotes**

SEA TO SEE stalked the pace three wide, made a brief run leaving the half, was outrun on the second turn but responded to steady pressure once straightened in the drive and proved best driving. IRISH WARRIOR was allowed to settle to the half, was forced out five wide while rallying on the second turn, closed well through the drive and just missed. SIR ALFRED had no speed, was caught outside of IRISH WARRIOR on the second turn and was fanned six wide to the stretch and made a late run through the drive. OUR MAIN MAN stalked the pace to the half, began to advanced on the second turn when asked, took a short lead in mid stretch but was caught in deep stretch. TORTUGUERO (IRE) dueled on the lead to the far turn, responded and inched clear to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. LASTING TRIBUTE had no speed and could only improve his position in the drive. AZKABAN (IRE) saved ground to no avail. TAKIN IT DEEP had no speed and lacked a closing bid. CRAZY LARRYS was allowed to settle, came four wide to the stretch and had little to offer in the drive. JADE GREEN dueled for the lead to the far turn but stopped after traveling six furlongs.
