THE DR. IS A LADY was reserved off the early pace, commenced a bid three wide once on the second turn, was put to a drive nearing the quarter pole, drew even in mid stretch, ducked in twice in the final furlong but held. FANCEE BARGAIN saved ground to the backstretch, had to take back off heels at the five eighths, was boxed in from the three eighths to the three sixteenths, finally got out and closed willingly when clear. LADY CARA had no speed, began to pick up her pace on the second turn and closed very well in the final furlong. SPRING VACATION pressed the pace to the half, offered a bid approaching the three eighths, dueled for the lead to mid stretch then was outfinished. POTRA SKATER (ARG) was allowed to settle, raced three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed late response. GILDA (IRE) tracked the pace to the far turn but lacked a late rally. WRITEHOF set the pace to the half, dug in to meet the challenge of SPRING VACATION to upper stretch but weakened thereafter.
