HAZEN was unhurried to the half, commenced a bid and followed NO PESO NO DANCE on the second turn, shifted out into the stretch, rallied to the lead a furlong out and edged away late. NO PESO NO DANCE was allowed to settle, made a bold rush on the rail on the second turn, raced to the lead and inched clear to the stretch then was caught in mid stretch but held the place. SATIN DOLLY pressed the pace two wide to the half, also rallied on the second turn, was three wide to the stretch then was outrun to the wire. MAITA (FR) pulled early and was a bit hard to place to the first turn, stalked the pace to the half, was fanned four wide while rallying on the second turn then finished evenly in the drive. PERFECT PLAN set the pace to the second turn, lugged out into the second turn, was caught and tired through the lane.
