Footnotes

CARRIE CAN settled early, went three wide on the turn, closed steadily from the outside and was up in the final stride. MISS CLASSIC was well positioned off a quick early pace, came two wide into the stretch, responded and finished willingly. AUGUST QUEEN lagged to head of the lane, responded to close with unusual speed, had to steady sharply off SPITE AND MALICE in the deep stretch, shifted off quickly but couldn't quite get up. MARTINI ROSE, unhurried early, rallied just inside AUGUST MOON in a good try. STEH'S A STORM stalked from the inside and was gaining late. READING HABIT chased SPITE AND MALICE into the stretch but lacked a closing response. SPITE AND MALICE sprinted clear early, extended her advantage into the stretch but shortened stride badly in the final sixteenth. SCAR TREK turned in a dull effort. BEAMING YEAR settled early, checked at midturn and fell back steadily.
