Footnotes

PACHARA (GB) was outrun early, found a good spot inside and advanced on the rail to the stretch, shifted off the rail once straightened, rallied gamely through the stretch and was up in the final strides. PERFECT JUDGMENT was sent for speed and set a pressured pace, raced two wide to the stretch, responded gamely to deep stretch but was nailed on the line. BIG LEAGUE had no speed, found his way to the rail and rallied inside to the stretch, also shifted out slightly then closed fast in the final sixteenth but just missed. HAFLINGER (CHI) had no speed, raced two wide on the turn then rallied strongly in the final furlong. STUTTGART (NZ) was used early to establish position inside, checked off of PERFECT JUDGMENT'S heels when getting out slightly, recovered and rallied to almost get to terms with that one at mid stretch but tired in the final eighth. BARRON H was allowed to settle when being outrun early, got fanned four wide to the stretch then was closing ground late. POPPY'S COURAGE had good speed but was outprinted and pressed the pace, came two wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. TWENTYTHREEJAYBIRD was hustled early and stalked the leaders, raced three wide to the stretch but weakened in the lane. SHER CRAFTY bobbled slightly at the start and had no speed then was outrun. ESTAMBUL (ARG) tracked the leaders to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then had to steady when pinched in mid stretch and weakened. DEAS ISLAND tracked the pace to the turn, shifted out and came three wide to the stretch but gave out in the drive.
