Footnotes

MOST OF ALL raced under patient handling early to trail to the turn, saved ground while advancing on the turn, slipped through tight quarters inside ANAZEHA into the stretch to quickly gain command then drew clear driving under fine handling. POWER TO BURN stalked the pace from the inside, became boxed from just off the rail at mid turn, swung out into the lane to lose position but responded gamely and was finishing with good speed. SISTER ADIBA settled early, saved ground on the turn to rally into the stretch but lost some of her punch late. ANAZEHA (CHI) dueled from off the rail, dropped inside while maintaining a slim advantage on the turn but slackened once in the stretch. MISS TERASITA stalked the pace from the outside to mid turn and weakened. GHOSTLY VALLEY dueled on the lead two wide to the head of the lane and gave out.
