Footnotes

FACTUAL LADY was quick from the gate and sprinted clear in the opening quarter, extended her advantage to the stretch but was fully extended to last. ICY CHOICE was permitted to settle early, advanced three wide on the turn and closed steadily. BETTER DAZE raced up after the break to gain a forward position early, saved ground on the turn to move nearest the winner in the upper stretch and finished steadily. MADRINGA broke a step slow then quickly raced up inside, chased the winner to mid turn and weakened. SUMMER LITE stalked the winner for a half mile then slackened. NORTH BY SIX settled early, raced three wide on the turn but failed to respond. SHE'S GOTTOGETAWAY was always outrun. STAR AMETHYST gain a good spot early but came up empty in the final three eighths.
