TERESA ANN was away in good order and went right to the front, set the pace to the second turn, responded to upper stretch, was no match for the winner but held second. JESSI J was allowed to settle, saved ground to the stretch but finished evenly in the drive. FORTY PUREZA (ARG) tracked the pace to the half, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but could not muster a late response. DEPUTY SONG had no speed and was outrun. SISTER ADIBA stalked the pace to the half and gave out.
