SIERRA SWEETIE was unhurried off the fast fractions, closed the gap to the second turn, took the lead then drifted out into the stretch, continued to get out in the drive but dug in late to hold. BAI AND BAI was three wide to the backstretch and settled, made a bid three wide on the second turn, was fanned out further into the stretch then lugged inward in mid stretch but closed ground to loom menacingly to deep stretch but then was outfinished to the line. TALVERNA veered out at the start and was outsprinted, was asked for speed but was fanned four wide on the far turn then finished evenly late. I CAN SEE hesitated and broke slowly, lugged out on the backstretch and was five wide to the stretch and did not respond. COME ON MARGARET set very fast fractions to the half then stopped on the second turn. PET ZOLT chased the pace to the half from the rail but also stopped after six furlongs.
