FAMILY TALENTS was void of speed to the second turn, quickly circled rivals five wide into the lane to reach contention then continued to respond and was up late to win driving. SENDIPITY gained command into the first turn and crossed to the rail, set all of the pace then gave out only in the late stages. EL SIERRA TAHOE stalked SENDIPITY throughout but lacked the needed late response. CHULLA BEL was permitted to settle early from just off the rail, saved ground on the second turn but failed to rally. BANDERA NEGRA raced within striking distance early while saving ground to the backstretch, raced two wide on the second turn but did not respond. LATIN ANGEL was never a factor. APPLETINI was die early but never threaten. CHIARA'S ANGEL was fanned five wide on the first turn then settled to gain a stalking position to the second turn and gave out.
