Footnotes

GO GAL GO prompted the pace to the half, shifted off the rail and rallied two wide to the stretch, forged to the lead a furlong out and edged clear driving. MY RUBY CHARM (NZ) tracked the pace to the half, shifted out and rallied three wide to the stretch, could not catch the winner but dug in late to collar GO GIRL GO for second. GO GIRL GO set the pace to the second turn, resisted the winner to mid stretch but weakened in the final furlong. LAND TAX never far back to the half, came two wide on the second turn, swung out four wide into the stretch then could not close the gap late. GRAN AMIGA (ARG) was allowed to settle to the half then had little to offer when asked for more. TEWKIN had no speed and was outrun. SATIN DOLLY had no speed and did not threaten. GOOD DAY SIR was allowed to settle, worked her way to the rail on the backstretch but gave out after six furlongs.
