FAST AND FAIR was used early and dueled for the lead to the turn, edged clear when asked and widened to mid stretch then was under steady urging to the line. SUNDAY DRESS was allowed to settle to the turn, got fanned four wide while attempting to rally into the stretch then finished best of the rest. MYSTIFING had no speed, settled then came three wide to the stretch and picked off rivals through the drive. ASSIGNED ROUTE stalked the pace to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch but did not rally. INDIAN PROSPECT had good speed, dueled for the lead inside the winner to the stretch but stopped in the drive. OLYMPICS GIFT bobbled at the start and was outrun. WILD TOY tracked the pace briefly but gave out after a half. RED TAFFETA saved ground to no avail. KICKIN FAST settled mid pack to the turn but stopped after a half.
