GUARDING GOLD broke alertly then took back just off the leaders, kept clear on the outside to rally four wide on the turn, forged to the front nearing the stretch and drew off while being kept to her task to the line. OTASTIE'S CROWN dueled inside a three horse spread to the quarter pole then couldn't go on with the winner but held all others. TORCHIERE settled early, went three wide on the turn and finished well but was passing tiring horses. PAMPERED PIRATE dueled three wide to the stretch and gave out. LAZOR LIGHT failed to respond. APACHE MISS dueled between horses to the stretch and came up empty. FALSE TRUCE saved ground to no avail. SHE'S A SHOW OFF was always outrun.
