LITTLE BIRD broke sharp then took back just off the dueling leaders, rallied to that pair three wide into the stretch, forged to the front leaving the furlong pole, drew clear briefly but was all out to hold. FASTCASH raced unhurried early, commenced her bid four wide on the turn and finished in a steady rally. PROSPECTOR'S CROWN dueled from the rail into the stretch and slackened. AWESOME AUDREY dueled outside PROSPECTOR'S CROWN to the upper stretch then lacked the needed closing response. IMMEDIATE CHANCE was permitted to settle early within striking distance, steadied and broke stride leaving the three eighths pole to slip back but responded in the lane and finished steadily. SIPTITZ HEIGHTS (IRE) lacked good early speed, saved ground and went evenly late. SUSANNE (GB) was never a factor.
