Footnotes

FLYER MINE broke in stride and dueled inside SWEET KENDALL JO to the stretch, disposed of that rival but kept enough in reserve to stall NO DERBY in the final stages. NO DERBY stalked the winner from the outset, followed that rival into the lane, shifted out once in the stretch and was slowly gaining. PROUD PATROLMAN was always forwardly placed, came two wide to the stretch but finished evenly. BADGER K. ELI lagged to the turn, angled four wide at mid turn to rally into the stretch then lost much of his punch. KAISER ROAD saved ground to no avail. SILENT EXPLOIT saved ground but had no speed. SWEET KENDALL JO dueled outside the winner to the quarter pole and stopped. AMERICAN MEMORIES tracked the dueling leaders early, raced two wide on the turn and gave out. DANCE THIEF raced wide throughout and was never a serious factor.
