CALIFORNIA LAURA broke alertly but allowed MEXICAN BEAUTY the lead in the opening quarter, tracked that rival from the outside but slipped back slightly nearing the stretch while drifting out, responded past the furlong pole however and was up late to win driving. MEXICAN BEAUTY raced up from the rail after the break to take a slightly early advantage, extended her advantage on the turn and upper stretch but shortened stride inside the furlong pole and could not hold. NAVY LASS was permitted to settle early outside EXPLICIT DREAM raced with that rival three wide on the turn but lacked a solid closing response. EXPLICIT DREAM stalked the pace from the inside, came off the rail on the turn but faded steadily. PEPE LE FEU had no speed.
