GENERAL ROYAL prompted the pace from the outset with little need of urging, forged to the front on the second turn, was put to brief urging in the upper stretch and quickly drew clear then was back in hand in the final sixteenth to win as much the best. KITTYS LINK was never far back, raced three wide throughout, offered a minor bid into the lane but proved no match. SUNDAY STROLL was void of early speed, commenced his rally three wide on the second turn but could not seriously threaten. KRAAL stalked the pace two wide but lacked the needed response. INVITATO MIO (BRZ) saved ground early but was never a serious factor. THETRUTHISOUTTHERE had no early speed, saved ground into the lane but passed only tiring horses. LAST MANGO INPARIS set all of the pace to the second turn under pressure from the winner then had nothing left for the drive. HIGH NOON MEETING had no response. MISTER FIRE EYES (IRE) stalked from the rail to the second turn, stopped and was eased through the stretch but walked off.
