HIT THE ROAD was forced to play catch up from the start, advanced on BLACK EYED LILLY to mid stretch, closed ground despite tiring and was best late. BLACK EYED LILLY set the pace, responded to pressure to mid stretch, tired and was caught late. MOETTE was outrun to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then finished evenly while closing on the top two. GOLDMINERS GAL had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch then made steady progress through the drive but did not threaten. CHANCY TOSS lagged to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch and closed the gap to the line.
