HOOKED ON NINERS tracked the leader from the rail to the second turn, closed to get to terms into the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then was under steady urging to hold. SISTER ADIBA was allowed to settle, advanced on the second turn the closed steadily in the stretch. QUE BONITA had no speed, closed a sizable gap from the half to the stretch then finished with a good late rally. GYRENE was allowed to settle, made a brief run on the second turn then finished evenly. FUNNY BONE was sent for speed and pulled away on the first turn, set the pace for six furlongs then tired. DEPUTY SONG settled inside to the half then had little to offer and gave out. JESSI J was not a factor.
