WELFARE CADILLAC was pushed out five deep into the first turn but attended the pace to the half, raced three wide and edged clear into the stretch then was kept to task to maintain his advantage to the line. ROYAL BRASS had no speed and settled for a half, advanced two wide on the second turn, angled out for room into the stretch then finished willingly late. FANTASTIC EVENT stalked the front runners to the half, raced two wide and offered his best bid on the second turn but lost his punch in the final furlong. COWBOY CRUISSER was three wide while chasing the pace to the half, rallied three wide to the stretch to briefly loom a factor but finished evenly in the late stages. BERNIE WHITE SHOES was forced four wide on the first turn, dueled between rivals to the half, came two wide to the stretch but tired in the drive. CODE AMOUR drifted three wide into the first turn while showing good speed, remained a factor to the second turn but stopped in the stretch. LADITUDE had brief speed only and stopped after a half.
