The host association's Guaranteed monies to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 15% to third, 7.5% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closed Thursday, October 19, 2006 with 14 nominations.

FLAMETHROWINTEXAN set the pace to the second turn, responded when asked to the stretch, dug in gamely when collared in deep stretch and earned a hard fought victory. FANTASTIC SPAIN was allowed to settle to the half, advanced inside on the second turn, remained on the rail and rallied to get alongside the winner in deep stretch but was held off in the final yards. DON INCAUTO (ARG) had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch then made steady progress to the wire. GRAFTON was unhurried to the half, commenced a bid when roused between rivals to the stretch then finished willingly late. PLACE COWBOY (IRE) tracked the pace from the rail to the half, made a run after shifting out three wide on the second turn, loomed to mid stretch then weakened. NOW VICTORY was taken off the rail early and pressed the winner's pace to the second turn, remained a factor to the stretch but tired through the drive.
