Footnotes

LOYAL BOUNTY broke alertly and settled in just behind the two leaders, advanced three wide on the second turn, challenged CALAMITY GIRL nearing the furlong pole, gained command and held determinedly. CALAMITY GIRL took a clear lead into the first turn and crossed to the rail, maintained her edge to the head of the lane, met the winner's bid and gave way grudgingly. BEAUTIFUL DIXIE settled early from the rail, eased two wide on the second turn but finished evenly in the lane. GEMSTONE RUSH stalked the pace from the outset, offered her best bid two wide nearing the stretch but slackened in the drive. BEST TRIBUTE lagged early, saved ground on the second turn and came on late without being a factor. VELVETY SMOOTH settled early from off the rail then failed to respond while three wide on the second turn. IN OTHER WORDS trailed to the second turn and passed tiring horses. SPARKLING STARLET raced unhurried early, came four wide to the stretch but did not rally. MODERATION was forwardly placed early but fell back nearing the second turn.
