Footnotes

SUN VALLEY ANNA had the best speed to the first turn, dropped over and set a reasonable pace to the far turn, responded when challenged by PAPIER MACHE to the stretch and held off that one under steady pressure. PAPIER MACHE tracked the pace three wide to the half, was asked for speed and advanced to put pressure on the winner two wide to the stretch then could not make a further gain in the drive. WOODFORD PRINCESS tracked the pace to the half, bid three wide on the second turn then had a mild late bid. WILD CHILD was in tight behind the winner and was briefly rank on the first turn, stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn but weakened in the drive. LITIGATOR stumbled at the start, recovered but had no speed, was three wide to the stretch but did not threaten. IN LOVE WITH LOOT was not a factor. VENTURE FOREVER pressed the pace two wide to the second turn then stopped.
