SOCCER DAN ducked in sharply at the start but recovered and raced up from the rail to prompt CALL IT for the lead, took command before a half mile, edged well clear on the second turn and held while being kept to his task. CALL IT set the pace outside the winner early, gave up the advantage on the backstretch, could not go with that rival but held well for the place. A SHORE THING settled early from the rail, eased out three wide on the second turn but could not rally. KAISER ROAD raced unhurried two wide early, dropped inside on the second turn and came on late. CORONADO'S WAY lagged to the stretch then passed tiring horses. BLACK HORSE MONEY failed to respond in a dull effort. MILITARY DEPUTY stalked three wide early but stopped on the second turn and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
