SAVOIR VIVRE broke just a step slow but quickly reached contention from the outside, was forced to circle the leaders five wide on the turn, gained command nearing the furlong pole and pulled clear driving. NEVER WEVER stalked the leaders from the inside early, checked a time or two into the turn while seemingly reluctant to race up inside the leaders, finally was hustled through to gain command nearing the quarter pole, gave way to the winner but gamely held the place while remaining on the rail. QUISTAMIRA dueled for the lead three wide to the stretch and weakened. CAL SWEET dueled just off the rail and had nothing left for the drive. MAMA'S CON raced wide and passed tiring horses. FASCINATION was never far back, saved ground on the turn but lacked a closing response. NO HAND OUT showed little. SHE'S SO HOT showed good speed from the outside to prompt the pace and gave way four wide on the turn. DIANE'S SONG was outrun.
