Footnotes

FLYING ALIBI raced up inside to take a slim advantage on the first turn, continued on the lead while racing off the rail on the backstretch, drifted out and brushed with VICE 'N REASON on the second turn while losing command briefly, responded once in the stretch and gradually pulled clear to win driving. VICE 'N REASON tracked the pace from the outside throughout, was brushed by the winner on the second turn and floated out into the stretch, offered another bid nearing the furlong pole but gave way in the final eighth. CRACKLIN ROSIE was void of early speed, saved ground on the second turn while advancing but flattened out in the drive. MEADOW SPRITE lagged to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and lacked the needed response. BREEZE GAL checked from between horses into the first turn to lose position then dropped to the rail, remained inside on the backstretch to offer her bid, held a slim edge at the quarter pole but had little left for the drive. SHADYBROOK LANE prompted the pace two wide and gave out. TRINITY TREASURE flashed speed four wide and slackened. BUCKSY was never a serious factor. The jockey aboard VICE 'N REASON lodged an objection against the winner for interference on the second turn but the stewards ruled the incident was minor and took no action.
