FORTUNATE CHANCE was pinballed between SUMMER'S COOL and DISTINCTIVE FLYER at the start and was outrun to the turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, responded and split rivals in deep stretch and surged to the front late. SUMMER'S COOL broke out and bumped the winner at the start, was on the early pace but was squeezed back nearing the half mile pole, steadied then raced four wide to the stretch and made a stout run to the line. LONESOME KNIGHT stalked the pace to the turn, got fanned five wide to the stretch, rallied gamely to deep stretch but was outfinished. RIGHTBYU had no speed, saved ground and advanced on the turn, lost the whip at the quarter pole but responded to strong hand urging to deep stretch but was also outfinished. GRAND SEQUOIA attended the pace while saving ground to the stretch, responded gamely to pressure to deep stretch but gave way late. DISTINCTIVE FLYER bumped with the winner then was bumped by ROYALETTE at the start, drifted inward and tightened things up on SUMMER'S COOL nearing the half mile pole, pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, remained a factor to deep stretch but tired in the late stages. ROYALETTE drifted in and bumped DISTINCTIVE FLYER at the start, had good speed and dueled two wide to the stretch but tired through the final furlong.
