WE ARE STRIKE NG was carried very wide into the backstretch by LA NAVARRA, moved to a favorable striking position once clear of that rival, was three wide on the second turn then dug in gamely for the drive and was up late to win going away. INDIA DIVINA settled inside into the first turn, moved up between horses on the backstretch to challenge for command, bested ECUDIENNE from the outside at the furlong pole to briefly draw clear but could not stall the winner. SOCIETY DREAM lagged to the final turn, commenced her bid leaving the three-eighths, was fanned four wide into the stretch to briefly compromise her rally, but resumed her advance once straightened for the drive in a good try. ECUDIENNE took over from LA NAVARRA entering the backstretch to set a pressured pace from the rail then gave out in the upper stretch. TASSA saved ground but failed to respond. PENNE raced three wide throughout and lacked a rally. HOUSA DANCER was unhurried into the first turn while gradually easing to the rail, remained inside on the second turn but could not accelerate in a dull try. LA NAVARRA broke out sharply to took the early lead, bore out into the first turn then gradually faded.
