TIME TO HONOR dueled for the early lead then pushed clear of rivals on the backstretch, set the pace to the stretch, responded to steady urging and held. URBAN KING (IRE) was outrun to the half, rallied three wide to the stretch then finished willingly to the line. DERBY RIDER (ARG) had no speed, launched a bid into the second turn but was fanned four wide to the stretch then continued his rally to the wire. LION TROUBLE stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside and battled to mid stretch but weakened in the late stages. SPEED ROUSER was rank into the first turn, settled to the half, was boxed and forced to wait on the second turn the finished well once clear in mid stretch. STANTON stalked the pace two wide to the stretch then gave way. DOMINGO JUAN (ARG) had no speed and was outrun. FARGO SUNSET chased the pace three wide to the half, briefly loomed a factor mid second turn but stopped through the lane.
