Footnotes

LIGHT AMOUR broke cleanly but lacked good early speed, commenced her bid from on the turn from the rail and rallied into the stretch, shifted out leaving the furlong pole for room, quickly moved to the lead and edged clear driving. PEGAKISS settled early, advanced three wide on the turn to loom a factor from the outside nearing the furlong pole but was outfinished by the winner. SHEZAFRENZY ducked in at the start and steadied to fall behind, moved up outside the winner once on the turn to rally into the stretch, lacked room while being carried out by the winner inside the furlong pole, steadied off the heels of HIGH DRIVE late. HIGH DRIVE broke very quick to set the pace outside GLASS OF RED into the stretch, disposed of that rival nearing the furlong pole to again draw clear but slackened in the final sixteenth. UNBRIDLED MANGO lagged well back early, saved ground on the turn and came on late. STRESS FREE stalked the leaders three wide to mid turn and came up empty. GLASS OF RED rushed up from the inside after the break to duel with HIGH DRIVE into the stretch then had little left. DEAL THE HEAT was forwardly placed to the turn but drifted wide and was eased in the lane but walked off.
