ANOTHER VARIETY broke a bit slow and raced unhurried while angling near the rail, came two wide while collecting her stride on the turn, rallied steadily through the drive, forged to the front late and won going away driving. SNOWBOUND NAN was quickest from the gate and set the early pace from the inside, gave up the advantage to SWEET KENDALL JO on the turn but kept to her task, made the lead again inside the furlong pole but could not stall the winner. POLY OLE was permitted to settle early, raced two wide on the turn, challenged for command leaving the furlong pole but flattened out late. MISS LONESTAR raced close up early, was fanned five wide on the turn to lose position but finished steadily. SWEET KENDALL JO dueled outside SNOWBOUND NAN early, gained a brief clear lead on the turn but slackened in the final furlong. NORMANDY PRINCESS stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. MARDI GRAS RIOT had only brief speed.
