BADGETT'S MANGO raced well in hand early from the extreme outside, pulled her way to the leaders nearing the second turn, forged to the front and drew clear in the upper stretch under urging and held driving. RIVER ELLA stalked the leaders well in hand, lacked a clear path behind those rivals on the second turn, angled out when clear and offered a mild rally without being a serious threat to the winner. HOLY VISION R. N. set all of the pace from the inside but slackened in the final quarter. WHIMISCAL DAY lagged early from the rail, angled three wide on the second turn but did not rally. GABBY DANCER prompted the pace in hand but had little left when called upon. PASHMINA PRINCESS steadied early and was never a factor. MS ERICA pulled up on the first turn but walked off.
