Footnotes

LIL SISTER STICH raced up inside into the first turn to track the pace, was boxed for much of the backstretch and second turn, tried to split the leaders at the quarter pole, steadied hard and slipped back but kept to her task to finally find room between horses nearing the furlong pole, powered through then drew off to win driving. SLEWREEN settled just off the pace from the inside, advanced gradually into the second turn, swung out to be four wide into the lane, offered her best bid at the furlong pole but could not match strides with the winner. WINEPLEASURE prompted the pace two wide throughout, forged to the front nearing the furlong pole but had little left for the drive. COAST MERIDIAN set the pace from the inside to the stretch and faltered. MARVELOUS settled just off the leaders from the outside, tried to rally five wide on the second turn but came up empty. LIL BARHOP lacked early speed, saved ground to the three eighths pole, came off the rail then lacked the needed rally. FITTINGLY VALID showed little. TONIETTA was never a factor. BRIAN'S BEAUTY had no speed in a dull effort.
