Footnotes

LIGHTENING checked off SALISH LEGACY at the start and raced unhurried to the half, came three wide on the second turn, responded once straightened for the drive to close steadily, checked off WITH A SONG in mid stretch but was up in the late stages. TRUKNDOWNTHEAVENUE stalked the pace from the outset, gained a short lead in the deep stretch but could not stall the winner. ISLAND MAZE set all of the pace under pressure then shortened stride in mid stretch. WITH A SONG raced unhurried early, advanced three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed rally late. APOLLO CHARM stalked the pace early, saved ground on the second turn and came up empty. FORTUNATE CHANCE was well placed to the second turn then had no response. SALISH LEGACY saved ground to no avail. FROSTORIA bore out on the first turn and never reached contention.
