GRAND GAMBLE had the best speed, set a pressured pace to the stretch then responded to steady urging and held ANOTHER VARIETY safe. ANOTHER VARIETY The latter was outsprinted, rallied two wide to the stretch to threaten the winner, battled to the line but could not get by and was easily second best. MIZ SMOKE'UM was shuffled back slightly early, tracked the pace, had to steady hard away from SKIP N' DI on the turn, fell back quickly then did not threaten but finished well for the show. NITE JAZZ had no speed, saved ground to the stretch but was not a factor. SKIP N' DI broke alertly and had good speed, stalked the pace to the turn, jumped a shadow and veered out sharply forcing MIZ SMOKE'UM to take up, continued to jump shadows a couple more time then was steered outside but gave way in the drive. MEL MAR pressed the pace from the rail to the stretch then gave out.
