TOP LEESE took command from the start and set all of the pace from the inside, turned back HIGHLY GALLANT nearing the stretch, drew clear and held driving. DANGEROUS DEVIL lagged early from the rail, advanced two wide on the second turn, shifted out for the drive and closed a gap too late. HIGHLY GALLANT prompted the winner from the outset, had his best bid two wide on the second turn but slackened. I'LL TRY stalked early from the rail, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. POWERFUL PETE raced unhurried early, saved ground on both turns and did not rally. KENTUCKY SUMMER lacked good early speed, came four wide on the second turn and passed tiring horses. PARADISE COVE settled early and was three wide to the backstretch, came two wide to the stretch but did not respond. SELIMAN showed little. JOHNNY THE WATCH settled early, raced three wide throughout and came up empty.
