NUMEROUS XS broke cleanly and stalked the dueling leaders from the inside, waited for room on the second turn, shifted out into the stretch, rallied steadily and was up in the closing strides. HAJJI'S ALOHA engaged PENNY RACER from the outside once on the backstretch, dueled with that rival into the stretch, gradually forged to the front nearing the furlong pole but was tagged late by the winner in a game effort. PENNY RACER set the pace from the inside, was joined by HAJJI'S ALOHA on the backstretch, continued to duel with that rival into the stretch then gradually faded. UPLAND steadied off the winner's heels on the first turn and slipped back, raced unhurried to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a mild rally. NATIONAL EMBLEM broke a bit slow then raced up outside into the first turn to be three wide to the backstretch, prompted the leaders to the second turn then lacked the needed response while four wide into the stretch. RUHLAND showed little. The rider aboard PENNY RACER lodged an unsuccessful claim of foul against HAJJI'S ALOHA for alleged interference at the furlong pole
