Footnotes

KITTY'S CHOICE raced unhurried while three wide on the first turn, responded when called upon on the second turn to circle the leaders four wide, opened a clear lead nearing the furlong pole and was kept to her task until the final stages. DAZZLING DIAMONDS settled within easy striking distance from just off the rail, offered her best bid three wide on the second turn but could not match strides with the winner. FAIR HOSTAGE steadied sharply shortly after the break and fell back, advanced two wide on the second turn but lost much of her punch once in the stretch. AIRPLANE lacked early speed or the needed closing response. JANUARY GOLD prompted the pace from the rail early, shifted two wide to take command once on the second turn but had little left for the drive. PINK LIPSTICK, void of early speed, tried to rally four wide on the second turn and came up empty. RACING THE WIND set the early pace from just off the rail, dropped inside into the second turn and gave out.
