JABRELDAS SON void early speed, improved position. CHIEF TWO SPOTS unhurried early, evenly. DANISH LUCK shuffled back start, failed to menace. EL BEACH vied for lead between horses, gave way. HAGUES LUCKY BOY well placed, through after half.
