TOBY K set pace, inside, drew clear stretch, much the best, ridden out. LAC LUSTY stalked pace, between horses, second best. ZURICH (IRE) good position, between horses, passed tiring rivals. SCAT DANDY close up, 5 wide stretch, weakened. ECHO MIKE unhurried early, between horses, improved position. MACUE close up, gave way. DIGGING IN WASHITA well placed, faded. LIARS POKER unhurried early, evenly. RAPTURIOUS lunged start, no threat. ARTS AND TARTS close up, tired.
