TOO IRRESISTIBLE stalked the pace, gained command after entering the stretch the second time, drew off when ready after the third-last fence, struck and went to the wrong side of a beacon and was confidently handled. Following claims of foul by the riders of LOCAL TREASURE AND MYSTICIZE that TOO IRRESISTIBLE went off the course on the wrong side of the beacon, the stewards disqualified TOO IRRESISTIBLE, placed him fourth and disqualified him from purse money. LOCAL TREASURE saved ground stalking the pace, couldn't stay with the winner after the second-last fence and closed the margin under strong urging. MYSTICIZE trailed on the outside and lacked a late response. WHERE ECHO'S END led through the first circuit, stalked winner to the second-last fence while between horses, gave way but completed every jump.
