WILD N ROWDY waited patiently well back of the pacesetter, started his advance into the final turn, took aim in midstretch, duelled gamely and edged ahead the final yards. PROFESSOR MAXWELL rated a clear lead, was challenged on the final turn, dug in gamely to put that one away but yielded to the winner in later yards. POTENTIALLY rated close to the lead, challenged the pacesetter into the final turn, remained a factor to late stretch then weakened. ALUCKYPERK, unhurried, bid mildly into the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. MOVE WEST hit the seventh fence from the start and lost his rider.
