SALAH CHAMP chased off the rail, went up three deep into the far turn, took the lead outside a rival into the stretch and drew clear under urging. LITE THAT BABY UP chased inside then off the rail, came around a rival into the stretch and gained the place. WARREN'S JOE T. saved ground stalking the pace throughout and edged a rival for third. EYESABLAZIN stalked outside a rival then off the rail, took the lead alongside a foe into the final turn, dueled into the stretch and was edged for third. SUN CATCHER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled into the final turn, dropped back between horses on that bend and weakened. WARRENS TEMPTATION hesitated to be away behind the field, saved ground off the pace and was outrun and eased in the drive. PENNY MAKER chased outside a rival then off the rail, had the saddle slip forward on the backstretch and was eased in the stretch.
