MCKENZIES WAY stalked off the rail then inside, bid alongside a rival on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and drew clear under urging. TRAWEEK chased outside a rival, split horses three deep into the second turn, continued off the rail into the stretch and bested the others. CHIBITA angled in and saved ground, steadied between horses into the second turn, continued just off the inside and outfinished a rival for the show. ZIP CAT dueled outside a rival then inside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. ALYDIDIT broke a bit slowly and bobbed slightly, chased outside a rival, went up four wide into the second turn, continued off the rail into the stretch and did not rally. ME LIKEY MIKEY angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and did not rally. ZIPPINGAROUNDTOWN had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back into the second turn and gave way.
